RE: Agreement between Lake County and the Town of Howey-In-The-Hills for collection of storm debris from streets and right of way

Dear Mayor Sears:

Per the subject agreement activated by the Town of Howey-In-The-Hills letter dated September, 12, 2017, Lake County provided debris removal and monitoring services to the Town of Howey-In-The-Hills in the aftermath of Hurricane Irma. Additionally, the agreement was deactivated at the completion of the debris collection effort on February 15, 2018.

The calculation of Howey-In-The-Hills share has been determined based upon load tickets and monitoring service validation. At this time, the County is requesting payment for fifty percent (50%) of these costs. Once the County receives reimbursement from FEMA, a final invoice for the remainder of the adjusted balance will be submitted to the Town for payment.
