Tara: The change in taxes voted in the by Florida voters on Tuesday will cause a cut in funds from Lake County for the Library of about \$15,000 per year

- Had some problems with the computers but that's solved now.

Dairian: Getting settled back into a normal work routine now that the election is over.

Ernest: The Board Walk will be shut down because of the danger of rotting boards.

- A tree service has been hired to remove low hanging tree branches over town streets and cut back the Palm trees along Lakeshore and Griffin Park.
- Presented a plat rendering of the plan to solve the water line problem on Florida where the new houses are being built at Florida and S.R. 19
