

This budget proposal was prepared according to an onsite visit on 09/01/2021 by Signature's Project Manager Jeremy Myers and the instructions/scope of work outlined in **RFP 2021-007 Town of Howey-In-The-Hills, Howey Pier Project document**. If awarded, Signature Construction, Inc. is fully capable of completing the scope of work included in this proposal and does not foresee any conflicts of interest in doing business with the Town of Howie-in-The-Hills.

Our proposal is to construct as follows:

General Requirements:

- Building Permit
- Final Cleanup
- Dumpsters
- Supervision

Demolition:

• Removal and Disposal of existing deck boards and handrails to include all associated fasteners and railings.

Labor:

• Provide skilled workforce to install new decking, railings, and horizontal boards over entire surface of the pier as per: RFP 2021-007 Towne of Howey-In-The-Hills, Howey Pier Project document.

Materials to be used:

- Main dock span (144ft x 14ft) of 2 x 6 x 14 #1 Pressure Treated Marine Grade Lumber
- Wings on dock (28 ft x 12ft) of 2 x 6 x 12 #1 Pressure Treated Marine Grade Lumber
- Horizontal mid rail boards 708LF of 2 x 6 x 16 #1 Pressure Treated Marine Grade Lumber to be cut at 45 degree angles where spliced. (One below handrail and one at midway as currently constructed)
- Handrail (Top rail) to be 2 x 6 x 16 Pressure Treated Marine Grade Lumber with smooth edges on top.

Thermal and Moisture Protection:

• Supply and install marine wood sealant as per RFP 2021-007 Towne of Howey-In-The-Hills, Howey Pier Project document. (Substantial time will need to pass to allow new green lumber to adequately dry out before applying)

Fasteners:

• All fasteners to be #304 stainless steel as per in RFP 2021-007 Towne of Howey-In-The-Hills, Howey Pier Project document.



We have estimated the time of completion to approximately 4 weeks (not including time for permitting, *if required by the town*). The total time of completion is subject to change if client delays the notice to proceed.

We highly recommend allowing the new lumber to dry for a substantial period before applying the sealant to prevent internal rot. Cost for sealant is \$2,500.00 which is included in proposal budget and is to be disbursed after sealant is applied.

Additionally, we propose noting in the contract if we are awarded the project the Contractor be paid for the replacement of boards (labor and material) once completed.

The total budget for all the items above is:

Fifty-Five Thousand, Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$ 55,069.00)

Alternate #1: Re-use current stainless-steel bolts, nuts, and washers on handrail savings of: (\$500.00) The current hardware is in good working condition and in our opinion can be re-used for a project savings.
